Information

Seattle/Bellevue Package

- The Seattle Package departs the parking lot of Bellevue College at 6am sharp on Friday, July 5th. Travelers will return to Bellevue College around midnight the morning of Tuesday, July 9th.
- Parking at Bellevue College will be provided for Pilgrimage participants who are traveling on the bus. Information on the specific parking lot and the procedure for this will be sent in June.
- Lodging is not included and accommodations need to be arranged in Twin Falls, ID on your own. More information is listed on the Accommodations Sheet.

Twin Falls Package

- The Twin Falls package will meet the pilgrimage in Twin Falls, ID and begin at 6pm on Friday, July 5th.
- Travelers registering for this package need to make their own arrangements for transportation to Twin Falls, Idaho. **Transportation will be provided ONLY within the Twin Falls, ID area on Sunday and limited transportation on Monday. To help cut down on costs, Twin Falls Package participants are asked to drive themselves or carpool to CSI for the Saturday activities.** CSI is approximately a mile away from the hotels.
- Lodging is not included and accommodations need to be arranged in Twin Falls, ID on your own. More information is listed below.

General Information

- The Pilgrimage will officially begin in Twin Falls on Friday, July 5th at 6pm (MDT).
- Historically, the weather for the Twin Falls, ID during the time of the pilgrimage has been in the mid-80s and sunny. However temperatures have the ability to reach the mid to upper 90s but also as low as the low-70s. A cool breeze can be expected in the evening as well. Please plan accordingly.
- Pilgrims are advised that personal services and devices such as wheelchairs and oxygen will not be provided. Pilgrims in need of services of a personal nature are responsible for arranging for such services prior to registering for the pilgrimage and are encouraged to travel with a companion for such purposes.
- The Pilgrimage program will end approximately at 11am on Monday, July 8th.
- More information and additional details for the pilgrimage will be sent to participants as soon as registration forms and fees are received and confirmed.
